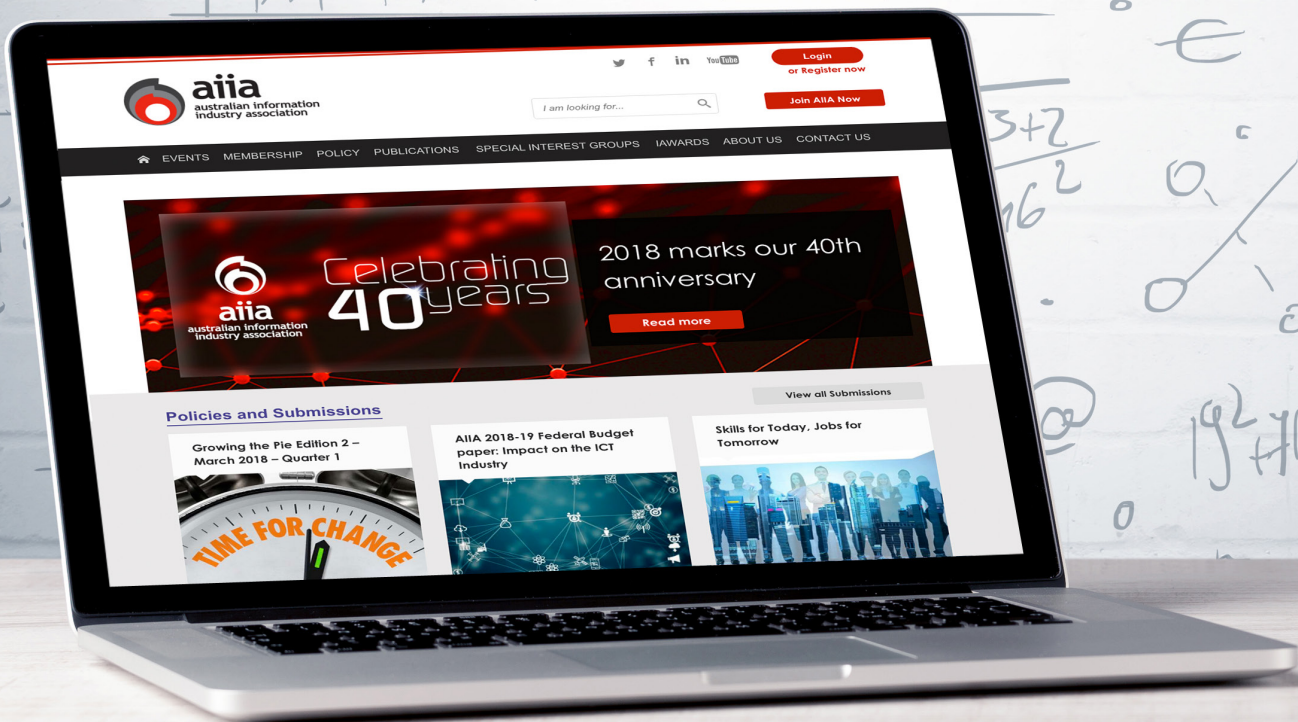


# Growing the Pie – Quarter 2

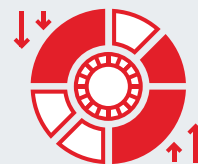




## Coordinated

The AIIA Policy and Advocacy team, with help from its members, coordinated the following meetings in the last quarter. These meetings were also attended by AIIA members:

1. The Second Cyber Security Roundtable discussion was held on 14 June 2018 with Gai Brodtmann, the Shadow Minister for Cyber Security. AIIA members' views were sought to help shape the opposition's Cyber Security Policy. Fourteen (14) AIIA members attended the Roundtable discussion.
2. Policy Dialogue Days – were held on 19 and 20 June 2018 with 9 meetings being set up by the Policy SIG with help from the AIIA Policy Team. Meetings were held with Senior Staff from Ministers' offices, the DTA and Ed Husic (MP). Discussions focused on forward agendas and current priorities as they relate to the ICT sector. Fifteen (15) AIIA members attended the Policy Dialogue Days.
3. A DTA and AIIA Cadence meeting was hosted by AIIA member, MXA Consulting, on 26 June 2018. Topics discussed included IRAP assessments, ICT procurement and changes to the DTA leadership. Twenty-one (21) AIIA members participated in the meeting.
4. The first X-Ship Steering Committee Meeting was held on 18 July 2018 in Sydney to discuss the program's priorities and the business model being proposed. Eleven (11) AIIA members attended the meeting.
5. The X-Ship Focus Group Meeting was held on 30 July 2018 in Sydney to discuss the higher apprenticeship business model and program specifics with industry stakeholders and members. Sixteen (16) AIIA members participated.

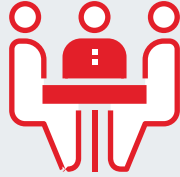

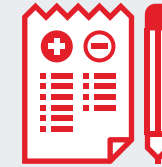
